**16 For their feet run to evil and they hasten to shed blood.**

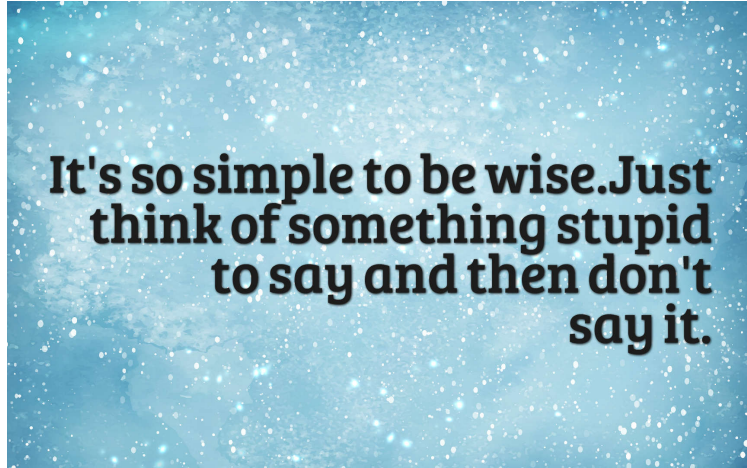

**1:22b - How long will scoffers delight in their scoffing**

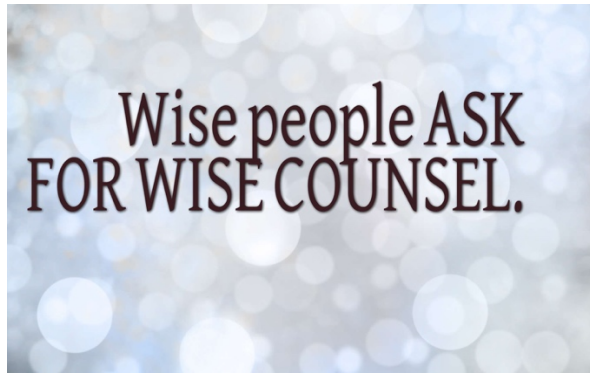
**Psalm 1:1-2**

**Proverbs 1:5**

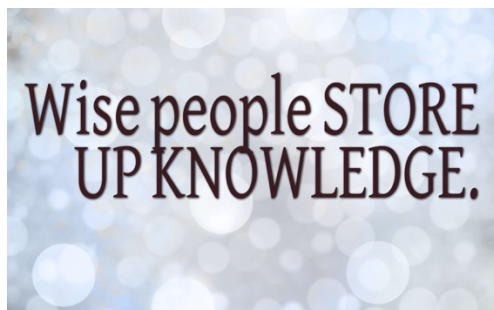
**5 A wise man will hear and increase in learning,
